Jeremy Wallace, son of Michael and Paula Wallace, attends Tri-Valley High School. Jeremy has played clarinet with BNYS for four years, and is concluding a ten-year legacy of Wallaces in the orchestra. He currently studies clarinet with Roger Garrett at IWU, and previously studied with Vicky Pletsch. Jeremy's favorite BNYS memories are performing with the ISO and watching his dad pretend to be Bugs Bunny in front of the orchestra in rehearsal. His personal musical highlights include attending the ILMEA All-District festival for all four years of high school and attending the ILMEA All-State festival for two years. He received four superior rankings for solos performed at IHSA Solo and Ensemble, earning best of day for two of them, and participated in Twin City Honor Band for three years. He also played principal clarinet in the pit orchestra for a production of *Pirates of Penzance* with Prairie Fire Theater. Besides playing clarinet, Jeremy also participates in Jazz Band, Scholastic Bowl, theater productions, National Honors Society, the WYSE team, and the math team. In the fall, Jeremy will attend the University of Iowa in Iowa City, to pursue a major in Chemical Engineering.
